

MASTER OF EDUCATION
SPECIAL EDUCATION OPTION (36 credits)

Keene State College and Granite State College (GSC) collaborate to provide special education teachers with an opportunity to earn a Master of Education Degree. The successful student will demonstrate competency for certification by completing a series of independent field-based learning experiences through GSC. Students at GSC will work with the GSC regional coordinator and a mentor from their school district. After the appropriate special education certification is awarded, students will complete course work at KSC during the fall and spring.

Minimum requirements: Completion of the appropriate post-baccalaureate teacher certificate program at GSC with a minimum of 18 credits.

Current certification in General Special Education, Emotionally Disturbed, Learning Disabilities or Mental Retardation

One year of full-time teaching experience.

Students who receive less than 24 credits will be required to complete up to 6 additional graduate level elective credits at KSC before they may begin **PHASE 2**.
