**\*\* The following criteria must be met prior to the award of transfer credit from the KSC post-baccalaureate certification program: General Special Education (PB.SPED).**

- Matriculated into the KSC PB.SPED program as of fall 2001 or later.
- Successfully completed the PB.SPED program.
- Currently certified by the NH DOE in General Special Education.
- Earned between 18 and 24 post-baccalaureate credits at KSC.
  - Candidates with fewer than 18 qualified credits are not eligible.
  - Candidates with fewer than 24 qualified credits will be required to complete up to 6 pre-approved elective credits at KSC. In this situation, it may take two years to complete the M.Ed.
  - Individual course grades below a B (3.0 on a scale of 4.0) are not acceptable.
  - Grades from the PB.SPED program do not count toward the grade point average (g.p.a.) for the M.Ed.
  - An overall minimum g.p.a. of 3.0 is required for completion of the M.Ed.
- Completed at least one year of full-time teaching experience working with children and youth in an appropriate educational setting (pre-K to 12).
- Employed, on at least a half-time basis, in an approved educational setting for the duration of the program.
